

ORDINANCE 17-383

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY CODE, SOLID WASTE CONTROL CHAPTER 105.02 DEFINITIONS AND CHAPTER 105.05 OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED, BY THE CITY OF WOODWARD, IOWA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODWARD

SECTION 1: That Chapter 105.02 DEFINITIONS is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 5. "Landscape waste" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5. "Landscape Waste" means any vegetable or plant waste. The term includes tree branches, brush, weeds, leaves, grass and yard trimmings.

SECTION 2: That Chapter 105.05 OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 4. Landscape Waste. Paragraph 5. Recreational Fires, and paragraph. 6. Residential Waste, inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4. **Landscape Waste.** Public Works will provide curbside pickup on Tuesdays. Pick up shall occur during the months of April, May, October and November. Citizens must call City Hall, for curbside pickup during other months. Landscape Waste must be placed out for pick up prior to 9 am. Branches must be bundled with twine or similar rope in sections not to exceed 5' in length. Leaves, grass clippings, weeds or brush must be placed in disposable bags. The disposal by Open Burning of dry landscape waste originating on the premises is only allowed during the Spring; the last two weekends in April from 9:00am-3:00pm. Fall; the last two weekends in October and first two weekends in November from 9:00am-3:00pm. Additional weekends may be added by order of the Mayor. At no time shall open burning of landscape waste originating on the premises shall be allowed when the State Fire Marshall or the County has imposed a burning ban.

5. **Recreational Fires.** Only seasoned wood will be allowed. Open fires for cooking, heating, recreation and ceremonies, provided they comply with the limits for emission of visible air contaminants established by the State Department of Natural Resources.

6. **No Residential or Commercial Waste.** The burning of residential or commercial waste is prohibited.


SECTION 2: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect

the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
