ORDINANCE NO. 22-411

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF WOODWARD, IOWA, 2006, BY AMENDING
SECTION 92.12 LEAKAGE OF WATER**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Woodward, Iowa:

SECTION 1. AMENDED SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Woodward, Iowa, 2006, is amended by replacing *Section 92.12 Leakage of Water* with the following:

92.12 LEAKAGE OF WATER. No reduction in billing will be made in the event of leakage after the water has passed through the meter. It is the owner's responsibility to maintain plumbing to prevent leaks. Any petition for relief from this ordinance for excessive water leakage and/or associated sewer charges shall only be considered and approved by an affirmative vote of the City Council in open session. This authority cannot and shall not be delegated to any individual representative of the City of Woodward.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, posting and publication as required by law.

Introduced this 14th day of February, 2022 and adopted by the City Council of the City of Woodward, Iowa on this 11th day of April, 2022.




