

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-5

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CIVIL PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH ESTABLISHED CITY ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, The City of Woodward has established Chapter 50 – “Nuisance Abatement Procedure” in the Code of Ordinances for Woodward, Iowa and;

WHEREAS, The City of Woodward has established Chapter 51 – “Junk and Junk Vehicles” in the Code of Ordinances for Woodward, Iowa and;

WHEREAS, The City of Woodward has established Chapter 151 – “Trees” in the Code of Ordinances for Woodward, Iowa and;

WHEREAS, The City of Woodward has established Chapter 155 – “Property Maintenance Code” in the Code of Ordinances for Woodward, Iowa and;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 19-392 amending the Section 155.06(1) Maintenance of Premises (Grass Height) declaring weeds or grasses in height of greater than six (6) inches, uncontrolled brush and tree growth, or any accumulations of dead weeds or grass are declared a nuisance and;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 19-395 amending the Section 155.06(11) Parking on Un-surfaced Portion of Yard and;

WHEREAS, This Resolution allows for the establishment of a civil penalty for non-compliance with an order of nuisance abatement from the Woodward Compliance Officer.

WHEREAS, Penalties will be assessed for instances of non-compliance of any established Ordinance, Resolution, or future Ordinance or Resolution approved by the City Council.

WHEREAS, Penalties will be assessed for specific instances of non-compliance and associated consecutive instances of the same offense during a 12-month period from the first instance and;


WHEREAS, This Resolution shall establish the following penalties

First Offense:	\$175.00
Second Offense:	\$250.00
Third Offense:	\$500.00
Fourth Offense:	\$750.00
Fifth Offense:	\$1000.00

SECTION ONE: The City of Woodward shall, and it does hereby, approve the above-stated civil penalties for non-compliance with an order or notice of non-compliance with a City Ordinance.


SECTION TWO: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from April 12, 2021.
